



# What Is LIHEA?



**LIHEA is the  
Low Income Home Energy Assistance program.**

**LIHEA** is a federally funded energy assistance program that assists eligible households with home heating and cooling costs in Nevada.

## Who Is Eligible?

Nevada households may be eligible if:

1. The total monthly gross household income, based on the size of the household, is not more than the amount listed below.
2. The countable assets owned by the household do not exceed \$4,000 for an individual living alone or \$6,000 for a household with more than one person.
3. The household is at least partly responsible for home heating or cooling costs by paying a utility company or fuel supplier directly or as part of the rent.
