It is the finding of this Office that the publication of the attached Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the <u>Healthy Homes Production Grant Program</u>, described by the attached funding notice FR-6700-N-44, does not constitute a major federal action having an individual or cumulative significant effect on the human environment, and therefore does not require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement.

The notice sets out the guidance to govern the Healthy Homes Production Grant Program, which is authorized under Section 501 and Section 502 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1970 (12 U.S.C. § 1701z-1 and 1701z-2), and funding is provided by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023, Public Law 117-328, approved December 29, 2022.
