It is the finding of this Office that the publication of the attached Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the Older Adult Home Modification Program described by the attached funding notice FR-6700-N-69 does not constitute a major federal action having an individual or cumulative significant effect on the human environment, and therefore does not require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement.

The notice sets out the guidance to govern the Older Adult Home Modification Program (OAHMP), which is authorized and funded by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 (Public Law 117-328, approved December 29, 2022, and the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022, approved March 15, 2022 (Public Law 117-103).
