Specifically, the STI Federal Implementation Plan:

- Details actions to be taken by **5 federal departments** and **15 HHS agencies** to implement the STI Plan through 2025.
- Highlights more than 200 action steps that span programs, policies, research, and other federal activities.
- Serves as a springboard for future action and planning among federal partners to address STIs in the U.S.

Federal activity alone will not slow or reverse trends in STIs. That is why the STI Plan is a national one, not just a federal one. The STI Plan is a call to action for stakeholders from ALL sectors of society to engage in a more coordinated national response to STIs. The STI Plan and the STI Federal Implementation Plan can provide inspiration to all nonfederal stakeholders, supporting their own efforts to identify and implement complementary actions that accelerate our efforts to address STIs in the United States.
