¹ The Court notes that the settlement provides for an initial payment and a series of regular monthly payments extending through April, 2016. The settlement also provides that in the event of default the government may treat any outstanding balance as a debt subject to collection, or re-file its Complaint, the Respondent having by agreement expressly waived the statute of limitations.
