RULING AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 8, 2011, the Secretary filed a Motion to Dismiss this case. The Secretary states that “[b]ased on a review of Petitioner’s current financial situation, HUD accepted Petitioner’s request to reduce the existing Administrative Wage Garnishment Order to reflect the revised and agreed upon garnishment amount of \$150.00 bi-weekly. Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss, ¶2. Without objection, the Secretary’s Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. It is

ORDERED that this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The Stay of Referral of this matter to the U.S. Department of the Treasury issued by this Office on March 23, 2011 is hereby VACATED. Administrative wage garnishment of Petitioner’s salary shall proceed at the rate of \$150.00 (one-hundred and fifty dollars) per two-week pay period until Petitioner’s debt to HUD is paid in full.
