**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**

On December 12, 2017, Jazz Fleming formerly known as Jaminta Fleming (“Petitioner”) requested a hearing concerning an alleged debt that the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) is seeking repayment for through an offset of Petitioner’s federal employee salary. The Court granted Petitioner’s request for a hearing and scheduled the matter for a hearing to take place on May 1, 2018.

HUD now moves to dismiss this matter on the basis that it has determined not to pursue the alleged debt. HUD states that it agrees to discharge the alleged debt and will no longer seek to offset Petitioner’s salary. In addition, HUD notes that Petitioner is aware that HUD will no longer pursue this debt and agrees that this matter should be dismissed.

Without objection, HUD’s *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
