
**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS**

On December 16, 2022, the Parties filed a Status Report stating that the Government had received a signed Settlement Agreement from Respondent. However, Respondent requested additional time to remit the payment required pursuant to the agreement. Respondent anticipated remitting payment by December 19, 2022, at which time HUD would then forward the Settlement Agreement to the appropriate HUD official for signature. Once the Settlement Agreement was fully executed, HUD would file a motion to dismiss the matter.

On January 6, 2023, the Parties filed a *Joint Motion to Dismiss Based on Settlement Agreement*, asking that the case be dismissed with prejudice based upon the settlement of the matter.

For good cause, the *Joint Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**, and this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
