ORDER REFERRING MATTER TO DEBARRING OFFICAL

Respondent requested a hearing before the Debarring Official concerning HUD's proposal to debar Respondent from future participation in procurement and non-procurement transactions for a period of three years. On October 17, 2022, the Debarring Official referred the matter to this Court to conduct a hearing and make findings of fact.

On March 17, 2023, the Government and Respondent jointly moved for a stay of all proceedings for thirty-days, based upon an agreed upon settlement in principle but needing additional time to fully execute the agreement and to make the necessary financial arrangements. The Court granted the stay of the hearing date and unelapsed deadlines.

On April 19, 2023, the parties filed a *Motion to Dismiss* jointly moving to dismiss the matter based upon a settlement agreement. The parties represent that the settlement has been approved by the Debarring Official.

As the disputed material facts are no longer being challenged, it is **ORDERED** that the allegations and proposed debarment are referred to the Debarring Official for disposition.
