ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS


The Debarring Official referred the above-captioned matter to the Office of Hearings and Appeals on April 26, 2023, and it was referred to the undersigned for hearing.

On May 8, 2023, HUD and Respondent Landa filed a *Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings Against Respondent Landa*. On May 9, 2023, the Court granted the stay for the requested three weeks and ordered the parties to file a status report on or before May 30, 2023. On May 30, 2023, HUD filed a status report informing the Court that the parties had agreed to a settlement, but needed additional time to execute the agreement. On May 31, 2023, the Court granted an additional two weeks in which to complete the settlement agreement and ordered the parties to file a status report on or before June 14, 2023, if a motion to dismiss had not been filed by that time.

On June 5, 2023, HUD filed a *Motion to Dismiss* on behalf of both parties informing the Court that the parties have settled the allegations against Respondent and the settlement has been approved by the Debarring Official. HUD attached a copy of the settlement agreement executed by both parties.

As the disputed facts are no longer being challenged as to Respondent, it is **ORDERED** that the allegations and proposed debarment are referred back to the Debarring Official for disposition.
