**ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL**

NOW COMES before the Court on November 30, 2023 Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss*, without prejudice, to collect the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because the Secretary has determined that "the debt collection is not legally enforceable against Petitioner at this time because the Petitioner filed a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Petition before the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of Texas, on November 20, 2023, as Case No. 23-32714. The Petitioner's bankruptcy matter is currently active and pending."

HUD shall retain the right to seek to collect this debt from Petitioner by any means available under the law should Petitioner's bankruptcy case be dismissed, or should Petitioner otherwise fail to receive a discharge of the debt she owes to HUD. Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**. It is hereby

ORDERED that the Stay of Referral previously entered in this case on August 24, 2022 is hereby VACATED.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 23-VH-0151-AG-082 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
