ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 11, 2023, the Tribunal received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter on the grounds that Petitioner has voluntarily entered into a Repayment Agreement with HUD. The Secretary adds that HUD may seek to resume collection activities in the future, should Petitioner fail to comply with the terms of the Repayment Agreement.
