ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 9, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner’s request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”).

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because HUD is no longer seeking collection of Petitioner’s debt by means of administrative wage garnishment. Rather, Petitioner and the U.S. Department of Treasury, which is servicing this debt, have agreed to reinstate a Voluntary Repayment Agreement that had been terminated. The Secretary adds that HUD reserves the right to seek collection by means of Administrative Wage Garnishment should Petitioner fail to adhere to the terms of the Repayment Agreement.

For good cause, the Secretary’s *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
