ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Petitioner filed a *Request for Hearing* dated February 12, 2024, disputing the existence of the debt claimed by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”).

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because Petitioner’s debt to HUD in the amount of \$33,536.75 has been paid in full. As a result, the Secretary reports that HUD has ceased collection activities against Petitioner and will no longer seek to collect the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment or otherwise.

For good cause, the Secretary’s *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
