ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On July 8, 2024, the Tribunal received Petitioner's *Hearing Request* wherein Petitioner requested a hearing regarding a debt claimed by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD" or the "Secretary").

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of this matter without prejudice because Petitioner and HUD have entered into a Debt Resolution Program Repayment Agreement ("Agreement"). Pursuant to the Agreement, Petitioner promised to make monthly payments until the subject debt is repaid in full. If Petitioner fails to make payments pursuant to the Agreement, the Secretary may pursue all legally available means of debt collection against Petitioner.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* is **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. Moreover, the stay of proceedings issued on July 10, 2024, is hereby **VACATED**.
