ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES BEFORE THE COURT, on December 6, 2023, the Secretary's *Motion to Dismiss* seeking to dismiss, without prejudice, its action to pursue collection of the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because "HUD has been unable to determine that Petitioner is currently employed. Accordingly, the Secretary will not pursue administrative wage garnishment from Petitioner at this time." Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**.

HUD shall retain the right to resume debt collection activities in the future, by means of administrative wage garnishment, should Petitioner's employment status change in the future.

The stay of referral issued on October 6, 2023 by *Notice of Docketing* is hereby VACATED should it be determined in the future that Petitioner's employment status has changed.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 24-VH-0003-AG-002 is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
