
**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

Petitioners filed a *Request for Hearing* dated March 22, 2024, requesting a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), and further claimed that garnishment would cause financial hardship.

The Secretary now moves for dismissal of the matter because Petitioners’ debt to HUD in the amount of \$31,566.15 has been paid in full by a Title Company. As a result, the Secretary reports that HUD has ceased collection activities against Petitioners and will no longer seek to collect the subject debt via administrative wage garnishment.

For good cause, the Secretary’s *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
