ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

NOW COMES before the Court a *Statement that Petitioner's Debt is Past Due and Legally Enforceable and Motion to Dismiss* (“*Motion*”), filed by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD” or “Secretary”) on July 8, 2024. HUD moves to dismiss, without prejudice, the action to collect the subject debt by means of administrative wage garnishment because the Secretary is unable to confirm Petitioner’s employment status for purposes of wage garnishment eligibility. HUD maintains that Petitioner is liable for the subject debt. Upon consideration, and for good cause shown, the *Motion* is **GRANTED**.

The Secretary retains the right to seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner at such time in the future that HUD determines is appropriate. The stay of proceeding issued on June 20, 2024, is hereby **VACATED**.

This matter of HUDOHA No. 24-VH-0298-AG-191 is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
