HUD's Multifamily Benchmarking Initiative is providing no-cost benchmarking services to eligible HUD-assisted properties. This Initiative will support efforts to lower energy costs as well as HUD's goals of promoting climate resiliency, preservation, and sustainability in the nation's housing supply. Benchmarking helps owners understand how their properties are using energy and water compared to similar properties. Owners are encouraged to enroll all eligible multifamily properties in their portfolios.

This program is targeted to HUD-assisted properties in good standing, including those receiving assistance under Section 8 Project-Based Rental Assistance (PBRA), Section 236 Preservation Program, Section 202 Supportive Housing for Elderly, and Section 811 Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities.

Technical **support**, guidance, and access to resources to benchmark their properties at no cost to them.

Analysis reports for each benchmarked property to help identify opportunities to save energy, water, and money.

AVAILABILITY

The Benchmarking Initiative will provide participating properties with technical assistance through 2027. Properties will be enrolled on a rolling basis until the program meets capacity for each year.
