

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Eastside Terrace, LLC and Eastside Apartments, LLC (collectively “Respondents”) and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“Government”) jointly move to dismiss this matter on grounds that the Parties have reached a settlement agreement. The Parties note that, pursuant to the settlement agreement, certain conditions must be met before the Government will release the claims asserted in this proceeding. As such, the Parties request that dismissal of this proceeding be without prejudice to the Government re-asserting these claims in the future, consistent with the terms of the Parties’ settlement agreement.

For good cause, the *Joint Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
