ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

On June 16, 2022, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") filed a Notice of Proposed Debarment ("Complaint") against Sanjay Choudhrie ("Respondent"). On July 15, 2022, Respondent requested a hearing. Accordingly, HUD's Debarring Official referred the matter to this Court on July 25, 2022, for findings of fact and a recommended decision.

On October 18, 2022, the parties filed a *Joint Motion for Stay of Proceedings*. The parties represented that they had engaged in settlement discussions and reached an agreement on major terms that they expected would resolve the debarment action. The Court granted the motion.

On November 2, 2022, HUD, with the consent of Respondent, filed a *Motion to Dismiss*. The parties have settled the matter and the settlement has been approved by the Debarring Official.

For good cause, the *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED**, and this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
