SUBJECT: Guidance on Unit Designation Categories and Accessible Designation Categories in IMS/PIC

Dear Executive Director,

On February 18, 2022, HUD published PIH Notice 2022-03, Guidance on Unit Designation Categories and Accessible Designation Categories in IMS/PIC. I'd like to highlight the importance of this notice and draw your attention to the requirements and deadlines it contains.

The notice defines the current Unit Designation categories in the Inventory Management System/PIH Information Center (IMS/PIC). These categories reflect whether Public Housing units are reserved for exclusive occupancy by elderly and/or disabled families. Accurately recording Unit Designations in IMS/PIC will support HUD's efforts to ensure that occupancy policies are applied in accordance with HUDapproved Designated Housing Plans and will also provide for the accuracy of funding calculations, as Unit Designation categories impact the calculation of Capital Fund Formula grant awards.

In addition, the notice defines the current Accessible Designation categories in IMS/PIC. These categories reflect the physical characteristics of Public Housing units that accommodate individuals with disabilities. This information will provide an improved picture of the availability of Public Housing units to accommodate individuals with disabilities and of compliance with Section 504 regulations and other applicable civil rights statutes and regulations.

The notice requires PHAs to review their portfolios in IMS/PIC to ensure the units are in the correct Unit Designation Categories and Accessible Designation Categories; to correct errors within 30 days of publication of the notice and no later than March 31, 2022; and to maintain the accuracy of this information on an ongoing basis.
