I am pleased to announce that the Public Housing Dashboard is now available. The dashboard provides unprecedented transparency and easier access to the Public

The dashboard can be accessed on the Public Housing Dashboard webpage.

The dashboard can also be accessed using this direct link.

The visualizations found in the Public Housing Dashboard include:

- Public Housing Unit Occupancy Updated daily
  - This page shares historical and current occupancy rates. HUD uses the Management Assessment (MASS) occupancy rate for calculating occupancy. More information on MASS occupancy can be found here.
- Funding (both Capital and Operating funding) Updated daily
  - This page displays funding information for the Operating Fund and Capital Fund programs.
- Public Housing Operating Subsidy Eligibility Updated daily
  - This page presents the eligibility for Operating Subsidy and the major elements that contribute to the formula's calculation. More information on the Operating Fund Grant program can be found here.
- **Resident Characteristics** Updated quarterly
  - This page provides national and state level demographic data on the Public Housing program. The data displayed on this page is sourced from the HUD-50058.
- Energy Consumption Updated daily
  - This page shows a summary of utility consumption and cost for PHApaid utilities in Public Housing. The data presented on this page is collected from the HUD-52722 during the annual Operating Subsidy (OpSub) eligibility process.

Additional items will be added to the dashboard webpage, including a data dictionary that defines each data point and its data source and a "how-to" video on how to utilize the dashboard. Additional clarifications for each visualization can be found on the "information" tab of the dashboard to help guide readers on how to interpret the data.

I hope that you find the Public Housing Dashboard to be a useful and user-friendly program management tool.
