

**Subject:** HUD Seeking Nominations for Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee

Dear Tribal Leader:

I am excited to share with you that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is moving forward with the next step in establishing the Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee (TIAC).

In the fall, HUD solicited Tribal feedback on the proposed structure of the TIAC. After thoughtfully considering each comment, HUD published a *Federal Register* Notice (FR-6289-N-02) this week that formally establishes the TIAC.

The Notice invites Tribes to nominate Tribal representatives to serve on the TIAC. Nominees must meet the criteria described in the Notice and nominations must be submitted by May 31, 2022. To submit a nomination, please go to Regulations.gov and press the blue Comments button. You can either upload a document or type a comment in the box that appears.

The establishment of the TIAC is an important step in honoring our government-to-government relationship by ensuring that Tribal leaders' views on all policy matters that impact Tribal communities are considered by HUD.

Thank you for your engagement and feedback. Your continued support has made the creation of TIAC possible.
