

Quick Refresher

The HIP Implementation Notice, <u>PIH Notice 2024-12</u>, describes the process for PHAs and their software vendors to transition from IMS/PIC to HIP.



Key Terms:

Transition Date: Access to IMS/PIC Ends

Transition Period: No Access to IMS/PIC or HIP

HIP Opening Date: Access to HIP Begins

✓ PHAs update their general email address in the Housing Authority module, on the Housing Authority tab.








6.1: ENSURING ACCURATE HA CONTACT INFORMATION

Ensuring Accurate HA Contact Information



- PHAs update their contacts in the Housing Authority module, on the HA Contacts tab.
 - ✓ ED
 - ✓ Board Chair
 - ✓ Local Official





6.2: ENSURING ACCURATE BUILDING AND UNIT DATA

Ensuring Accurate Building and Unit Data



- The B&U information is the basis for the calculation of Capital Fund grants and for the Project Expense Level (PEL) calculations for Operating Fund grants.
- To prevent improper payments, PHAs are required to ensure the accuracy of this information.


6.2.A: B&U DATA THAT MUST BE VALIDATED BEFORE THE TRANSITION DATE

B&U Data that Must be Validated Before the Transition Date

In reviewing their B&U data, PHAs should prioritize:

- ✓ Unit Counts
- ✓ Bedroom Counts
- ✓ Unit Designations
- ✓ Accessible Designations
- ✓ Unit Tenant Statuses
- ✓ Dwelling Units, Non-Dwelling Units, Non-Dwelling Structures, Total Acres, and Total Removed Acres






6.2.A: B&U DATA THAT MUST BE VALIDATED BEFORE THE TRANSITION DATE, *Continued...*

B&U Data that Must be Validated Before the Transition Date, *Continued...*

PHAs are encouraged to run a Unit Detail Report in the Development Submodule, Reports tab, Unit Report subtab.



- For the Report Type, select "Detailed".
- Select the Occupancy checkbox.
- As of the Transition Date, PHAs must ensure that NO units have a Unit Status Type of: "Status Changes Proposed", "Status Changes Submitted", "Status Changes being Reviewed", or "Proposed for Removed from Inventory".




6.2.B: REQUIREMENT TO COMPLETE B&U SUBMISSION AND APPROVAL IN IMS/PIC

Requirement to Complete B&U Submission and Approval in IMS/PIC

After B&U updates, and no later than 2 weeks prior to the Transition Date, PHAs must submit their Building and Unit data for approval in IMS/PIC.

- Select Development Submodule.
- Select Submission tab.
 User arrives on Submit
 Unit Information
 subtab.
- 3. Enter brief comment.
- Select Submit Data for Approval.




6.3: ENSURING ACCURATE TENANT DATA

Ensuring Accurate Tenant Data

HUD will migrate:

- ✓ All current HUD-50058 and HUD-50058 MTW records.
- ✓ A limited subset of historical records accepted by IMS/PIC.



HUD will <u>not</u> migrate:

- x Form HUD-50058 submissions that received fatal errors.
- x Error reports.




6.3.A: CONSIDERATIONS IN TENANT DATA MIGRATION

Considerations in Tenant Data Migration

In reviewing their tenant data, PHAs should:

✓ Ensure that the active households listed in their internal records match those in IMS/PIC and that the most recent 50058, including type of action and effective date, is correctly reflected.



✓ Ensure that any fatal errors on error reports in IMS/PIC have been resolved.

6.3.B: RESOURCES FOR RECONCILING TENANT DATA PRIOR TO TRANSITION DATE

Resources for Reconciling Tenant Data Prior to Transition Date

PHAs should use existing processes and work with their software provider to ensure accurate tenant data.

PHAs may also use:

- ✓ IMS/PIC Adhoc Report
- ✓ IMS/PIC 50058 Error Reports
- ✓ PIC Error Dashboard
- ✓ Errors Flagged in EIV

6.4: ENSURING DATA ACCURACY FOR CY 2025 OPERATING SUBSIDY

Ensuring Data Accuracy for CY 2025 Operating Subsidy

HUD will pull unit status data from IMS/PIC on or around August 1, 2024, to calculate CY2025 Operating Fund grants (covering 7/1/23 - 6/30/24).



PHAs can support funding accuracy by:

- ✓ Following the requirements of the HIP Implementation Notice.
- ✓ Timely transmitting HUD-50058s effective during the reporting period, in accordance with FMD guidance.

7.3: CONSIDERATIONS FOR PHAS CLOSING OUT THEIR PH PROGRAMS

Considerations for PHAs Closing Out Their Public Housing Programs

Applies to PHAs that no longer have any Public Housing ACC units and intend to close out their PH program.

- ✓ If closing out PH program through ACC termination*, PHA must work with field office to complete the close-out process.
- ✓ If closing out PH program through voluntary transfer or consolidation AND the effective date precedes the Transition Date, PHA must work with field office to complete the process in IMS/PIC.

* PHAs intending to receive funding to be used for eligible close-out expenses should NOT terminate their ACC and will NOT be made inactive in HUD systems.

7.4: CONSIDERATIONS FOR PHAS SUBMITTING INVENTORY REMOVAL APPLICATIONS

Considerations for PHAs Submitting Inventory Removal Applications

- HUD will not accept inventory removal application submissions in IMS/PIC after July 1, 2024.
- HUD will migrate all applications and documents to HIP.
- PHA should consult field office if they need to submit between July 2, 2024, and the HIP Opening Date.
- RAD inventory removal application inquiries: send to SACTA@hud.gov.
