<a href="#">PIH 2023-07</a>	Implements the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program funding provisions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023.
<a href="#">PIH Notice 2022-30</a>	Provides for the extension of currently approved regulatory waivers for (1) increasing the payment standard during the HAP contract term and (2) new payment standard amounts through December 31, 2023.
<a href="#">PIH Notice 2022-18</a>	Provides guidance on the use of HCV and Mainstream voucher ongoing administrative fees for expenses related to assisting HCV and Mainstream Voucher families to lease units, including the costs of security deposit assistance and landlord incentive and retention payments.
