

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

This action was initiated on August 20, 2010, by the filing of a Complaint by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) against Respondent pursuant to the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812 (“the Act”), and the Act’s implementing regulations at 24 C.F.R. Part 28 (“Rules”).

On December 17, 2010, HUD filed a Motion to Dismiss Based on Settlement Agreement (“Motion to Dismiss”), and attached a Settlement Agreement between HUD and Respondent. Signed by Flossie Blango on November 29, 2010, and by counsel for HUD on December 10, 2010, the Settlement Agreement attests that Respondent agrees to pay \$1,000 to HUD in two installments. The Rules provide that the parties “may enter into a settlement agreement at any time prior to the issuing of a notice of final determination.” 24 C.F.R. § 28.45(a).

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the Motion to Dismiss is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** due to the parties’ execution of a Settlement Agreement.
