
DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT

The Government filed a *Complaint* against Respondents seeking the imposition of a civil penalty and assessment totaling \$113,051.26, jointly and severally, pursuant to the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812, and 24 C.F.R. Part 28.

Thereafter the parties engaged in settlement discussions that resulted in two settlement agreements resolving all issues in the matter. As a result, and pursuant to those agreements, the Government requested dismissal of the matter on May 12, 2015. Copies of the agreements are attached to the *Government's Motion to Dismiss Complaint Based on Settlement Agreement* ("Motion"), but the Court has not been asked to review or approve them.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Government's *Motion* is **GRANTED** and the matter is **DISMISSED**.
