
ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On July 22, 2015, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) filed a *Complaint* against Jose Ramon Boria Figueroa and Maria Teresa Irizarry Romero (“Respondents”) seeking three civil penalties under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986 and 24 C.F.R. Part 28, for a total award of \$22,500. The *Complaint* alleged Respondents submitted false statements to HUD in connection with the Home Equity Conversion Mortgage Program.

On November 10, 2015, HUD moved for dismissal of the matter as the parties have reached a settlement. HUD attached a copy of the settlement agreement as support for its *Motion to Dismiss*.

For good cause, and without objection, the HUD’s *Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED** and the matter is **DISMISSED**.
