ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

On September 1, 2015, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) filed a *Complaint* against Land/Home Financial Services, Inc. (Respondent) seeking a civil penalty of \$7,500 and an assessment of \$181,582 for a total award of \$189,082 under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986 and 24 C.F.R. Part 28. The *Complaint* alleged Respondent submitted false claims to HUD in connection with HUD's Federal Housing Administration Single Family Mortgage Insurance Program administered pursuant to Section 203(b) of the National Housing Act, as amended, 12 U.S.C. § 1709(b).

On February 17, 2016, HUD moved for dismissal of the matter as the parties have reached a settlement. HUD attached a copy of the settlement agreement as support for its *Motion to Dismiss*, but did not ask the Court to review or approve the agreement.

For good cause shown, HUD's *Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED** and the matter **DISMISSED**.
