
ORDER GRANTING GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On December 29, 2015, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) filed a *Complaint* against Respondents seeking civil penalties pursuant to the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act.¹

HUD now moves for dismissal of this matter on the basis that the parties have negotiated a settlement agreement, which was executed on April 6, 2016. A copy of the Settlement Agreement was attached to the *Government's Motion to Dismiss*, but the Court was not asked to review or approve it.

For good cause, the *Government's Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED** and the matter is **DISMISSED**.
