DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT

On February 11, 2016, Counsel for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) filed a *Complaint* against Respondents John A. Clark, Andre J. Arellano, and Tommie T. Young seeking civil penalties and an assessment under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812.


On July 8, 2016, the Court issued an *Order Dismissing Proceedings Against Respondent Young* due to settlement.

On July 20, 2016, the Court issued an *Order Dismissing Proceedings Against Respondent Arellano* due to settlement.

On August 1, 2016, HUD filed a *Notice of Withdrawal of Complaint Against Respondent John A. Clark*. HUD and Respondent Arellano have reached a settlement agreement. Accordingly, the case is hereby **DISMISSED** against Respondent Clark.

As this matter has been resolved against all Respondents, HUD has moved to dismiss the Complaint. For good cause shown, HUD’s motion is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
