
DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT

On July 20, 2016, Counsel for the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) filed a *Complaint* against Herbert M. Owens (“Respondent”) seeking civil penalties under the Program Fraud Civil Remedies Act of 1986, 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801-3812.

Thereafter, Respondent and HUD reached a settlement agreement resolving all of the issues of this case. As such, HUD now moves for dismissal of the matter and attaches a copy of the fully executed settlement agreement in support.

For good cause, the *Government’s Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED**.
