
DISMISSAL ORDER

This matter arises from a *Complaint* filed by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) against James Mike Lee and Vicki Wong, also known as Vicki Wong Rivera, (collectively, “Respondents”), pursuant to 31 U.S.C. §§ 3801, *et seq.*, as implemented by 24 C.F.R parts 26 and 28.¹

On July 11, 2019, the parties filed a *Joint Motion to Dismiss* asking the Court to dismiss this matter with prejudice on grounds that the parties have executed a settlement agreement, a copy of which was submitted with the motion, fully resolving HUD’s claims against Respondents.

As no issues remain to be decided in this matter, the parties’ *Joint Motion to Dismiss* is hereby **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
