CHAPTER 11. MICROCOMPUTER POST-IMPLEMENTATION EVALUATIONS

- 11-1. POLICY STATEMENT. IPS is responsible for conducting microcomputer post-implementation reviews for all users six months to a year after receipt of a microcomputer system.
- 11-2. PURPOSE OF EVALUATION. The evaluations will provide information on applications the users have developed, problems encountered and utilization data. They will also show where possible configuration changes or reallocations are needed.
- 11-3. PROCEDURES. IPS is responsible for determining the procedures to be followed in conducting the evaluations. Where it is determined that full utilization of an organization's microcomputer system is not being realized, IPS must conduct a follow-up evaluation within six months. Based on the results of the evaluation, equipment may be removed or reallocated.
