 2. Summary. This Handbook provides grant management procedures for use by HUD Regional and Field Offices, Public Housing Agencies, Indian Housing Authorities, Resident Councils, Resident Management Corporations, certain State and local entities, housing cooperatives, and non-profit organizations participating in the following programs:
 - Resident Management Technical Assistance Program
 - Drug Elimination Program
 - Youth Sports Program
 - Homeownership and Opportunity for People Everywhere for Public and Indian Housing (HOPE 1)

The procedures in this Handbook are used from the time of receipt of grant applications at local HUD Offices through grant closeout by local HUD Offices and all inclusive activities.

3. Forms. A list of all forms used with this Handbook is provided following the Table of Contents and a copy of all forms listed and applicable instructions are provided in Appendix 2.
4. Data Resources. The use of the Grants Management module in the System for Management Information Retrieval for Public Housing (SMIRPH), the Management Information Retrieval

System (MIRS) for Indian Housing, and the Line of Credit Control System - Voice Response System (LOCCS-VRS) is required with this Handbook.
