Total operating subsidy eligibility and funding amounts for all PHAs, and therefore proration levels, may change once all Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2008 operating subsidy forms and revisions have been processed. Adjustments will be made based on approved FFY 2008 applications.

The amount of your agency's obligated funds is available through *e*LOCCS. All funds must be used in accordance with the Annual Contributions Contract and associated laws and regulations. Instructions for the use of *e*LOCCS are in Notice PIH 2002-28 (HA), Use of *e*LOCCS (electronic Line of Credit Control System) to Request Operating Subsidy Payments and Elimination of Form HUD-52721.
