The training will be interactive, using case studies and exercises as well as opportunities to learn from best practices and peers.

- Cost price analysis;
- Best practices in bidding;
- Applying Indian Preference and Tribal Preference;
- Different procurement techniques for construction contracting, particularly in rural areas;
- Developing a procurement plan;
- Conflict of interest policies and procedures.
