SUBJECT: Updated Instructions to Download the Indian Housing Plan From the Internet

On January 29, 1997, the HUD Homepage was revised and updated to better serve our customers. Due to the changes, the information provided in NAHASDA Guidance 98-08, *Preparation and submission of the first Indian Housing Plan (IHP)*, needs to be updated.

Specifically, the steps listed in the answer to question number 4 describing how to download the final version of the IHP from the Internet no longer apply. The easiest way to access the final version of the IHP from the Internet is to simply type in the address of the site where the IHP is located. To do this, go to the address or netsite box and type <http://www.hud.gov/forms/52735.pdf>. This will take you directly to the IHP form and allow you to print it.
