Dear Tribal Leader:

On behalf of Secretary Julián Castro and the Office of Public and Indian Housing, we are proud to announce the establishment of HUD's first Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee. The Committee will facilitate intergovernmental communication between HUD and tribal leaders on all HUD programs, make recommendations regarding current program regulations, advise HUD on American Indian and Alaska Native housing priorities, and strengthen capacity building opportunities. The Committee will further enhance regular, meaningful consultation and collaboration between federal and tribal officials.

Enclosed for your review is a copy of the *Federal Register* notice, "Establishment of Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee; Request for Nominations for Tribal Intergovernmental Membership [FR-5951-N-02]," which was published today. The notice provides details of the Committee's structure, membership eligibility, and invites nominations.

On June 23, 2016, the *Federal Register* published the Proposal to Establish a Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee; Request for Comments on Committee Structure [FR-5651-N-03].
